- Completed <u>Application Form</u>
- Resume and cover letter. On your resume, please be sure to indicate the clinical population worked with, where sessions were held, whether they were individual or group sessions, and include the start and end dates at each clinical site.
- Official transcripts from all universities attended.
- Three letters of recommendation sent by the writer.
 - one letter from the Music Therapy Program Director
 - one letter from an MT-BC Clinical Supervisor
 - one letter from a supervisor of a non-music therapy related job or position.
- Video link or digital attachment of clinical skills. At least one of these videos must be with another person. State the goal and objective at the beginning of the video. Do not use actual clients.
 - A video of you singing and playing a song on the guitar that you would use during a session with an adolescent client diagnosed with Autism needing to develop appropriate social skills.
 - A video of you singing and playing a song on the piano that you would use during a session with an adult client diagnosed with an intellectual or developmental disability needing to engage with others using verbal and non-verbal communication.
 - A video of you singing a song a capella that you would use during a session with an older adult client who resides in a facility, is diagnosed with dementia and is anxious.
- Using 2 of the videos above, provide 2 examples (1 for each video) of clinical writing documentation. This can be a written chart note or a data collection sheet.
